## **Library Operations**

The 2022-23 budget vote will be held April 5, 2022, from 9:30 am to 9:00 pm. Michele Zaransky, Claims Auditor, will oversee the vote count.

A proposed revision of the By-Laws was reviewed by the Policy Committee and approved by counsel. The proposal to amend the By-Laws by a 2/3 vote of the Board at next month's meeting will be advertised as required.

The Building Committee conducted a visual inspection of building conditions with the consultant on March 21 and identified repairs required for the front stairs, sidewalk by the outdoor rest rooms, and rebuilding berms on the side of the building. Specifications for each project will be prepared for distribution to contractors for preparation of quotes.

Dr. Podell reported that NYS Library Construction Aid is available for solar panel work. Several firms make panels that resemble shingles. Dr. Podell will obtain quotes to determine if the project would be financially feasible.

Dr. Podell will provide Board members with the newsletter draft for review prior to mailing to the public.
