## Meeting Minutes

## Financial Matters

The Treasurer's Report dated November 30, 2022, was presented as follows:

A motion to accept the Claims Auditor's report dated $1 / 5 / 23$ was made by Edward Price, seconded by Vincent Parziale, and approved unanimously.

Dr Podell presented the draft 2023-24 library budget in the amount of \$3,029,006 with a tax levy increase of $2.60 \%$. The tax levy is the same as 2022-23 and below the tax levy cap. The board will vote on the proposed budget at the February meeting.

## Library Operations

Dr. Podell indicated that the 2023 budget/trustee vote will be on Tuesday April 11. Trustees Richard Hamburger, Janice Rochstein, and Richard Schuster are due to run for three-year terms. The budget hearing and meet candidates' night is Monday March 20 at 7 PM.
